To Our Valued Customers,

Beginning Monday May 4th, the clubhouse and Snack Bar will be open again to traffic. So, with this opening of the Clubhouse and Snack Bar comes with it some restrictions and changes throughout the facility and the golf course. The South facing door will remain locked. You may enter and exit the facility by using the East and North facing doors. The Pro Shop will have marked areas (orange tape) on the floor to help control the number of people in the building. Please enter the building with caution and pay attention to signage in place, to make this as simple as possible for everyone. It is also during this time that we remind everyone to please practice the social distancing measures put in place when in the building and when waiting to make your way into the building as well. We thank you in advance for your due diligence during this time.

As of Monday, the flags will be back on the greens and the cups will have the noodles in them, so the ball has a chance to come to rest below the surface of the ground. Please do not remove or touch the flags for any reason. In an effort to alleviate the excessive cart traffic, we will be moving away from the single rider carts. Each tee time that has three or more players will be allowed two golf carts. For those with concerns, single rider carts will be available and at a rate of \$29.00 for 18 holes and \$18.00 dollars for 9 holes, please make it known to the golf staff when checking in that you will be requesting a single rider cart and we will make sure to provide one for those requests. The rakes, benches and water coolers will not be placed on the golf course at this time. It is with great relief that we get to open our doors again see your smiling faces and welcome our customers back into our building. We sincerely appreciate your support and patience during the past several weeks.

Here are some details concerning the operation of the Snack Bar as provided by Bryan Ziegenbein (Clubhouse Manager) – We are anxious to get back to serving our golf customers as we have over the past 28 years. We know that you enjoy all aspects of our golf experience, from playing the game you love, enjoying the friends and family you golf with and the laughter of stories shared with beers after your game. These are unchartered times with guidelines of operation changing frequently. At this time, we are opening the snack bar to 20 people (5 tables of 4 people). This table service and seating is only for those ordering a meal (hotdogs and/or sandwiches) per Nebraska guidelines. Once the meal is consumed, customers will then need to leave the building in order for our facility to maintain compliance. All other snack bar services of drinks and snacks will be completed outside the building, as we have done over the past several weeks, weather permitting. All snack bar items will be available for purchase and made to go for those not wishing to enter the building.

We will continue following social distancing guidelines outside in efforts to maintain lingering crowds before and following play. To do this, the snack bar will close services at 7:30 pm daily. This time will continue to be evaluated in the weeks ahead.
